Eligibility requirement on entry into the program

You must be a Member of ACN to apply for the ENL Program.

FOR REGISTERED NURSES:

Applicants must be pre-registration students completing one of the following at an Australian University: Bachelor of Nursing (final year), Nursing Masters or Nursing Honours year.

FOR ENROLLED NURSES:

Applicants must be students completing a Diploma of Nursing

February – October (9-month program)

INDIVIDUAL FOCUS (Self-awareness)

Participants will focus on the identification of leadership qualities and skills. Participants will identify their own potential leadership qualities and seek to recognise how these qualities may be utilised to enhance their professional learning.

Applicants must be an employed Enrolled Nurse in their first year of nursing practice.

February – October (9-month program)

TEAM FOCUS (Growing awareness of influence on others)

Participants will focus on identifying and analysing leadership qualities and skills. Participants will identify and analyse their own leadership qualities and how these qualities can be developed to positively influence their own and others' professional growth.
